This afternoon through late tonight




- Multiple slow moving showers and thunderstorms along a stalled front may bring 1 to 3 inches of rain with localized amounts around 4 inches
- Isolated to scattered instances of flooding will be possible over parts of Virginia and the eastern panhandle of West Virginia
- The Flood Watch may need to be expanded north and westward later this morning

Wednesday





- Isolated severe thunderstorms are possible on Wednesday, but confidence is low.

Above normal temperatures favored




